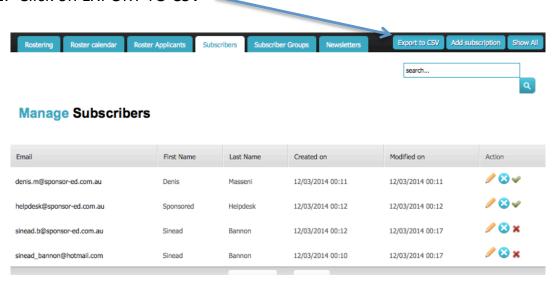


Exporting to .csv

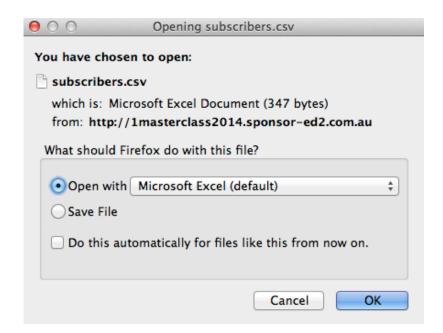
