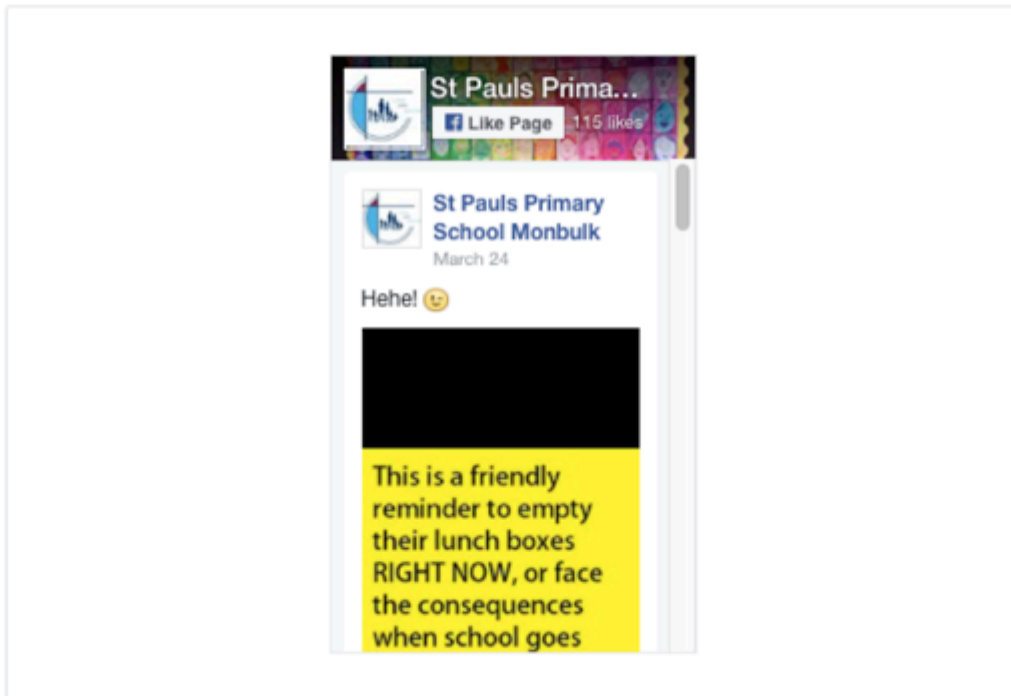


# Adding a Facebook Feed to your Website

1. Go to <https://developers.facebook.com/docs/plugins/page-plugin>

2. Add school's Facebook URL
3. Adjust dimensions to Width 245 Height 400 (recommended). You can alter Height to suit but leave Width as 245.
4. Tick Use Small Header (recommended, but you can play with tick boxes to suit your own look)
5. Click GET CODE

# Adding a Facebook Feed to your Website

Javascript SDK | IFrame

**Step 2:** Include the JavaScript SDK on your page once, ideally right after the opening <body> tag.

```
<div id="fb-root"></div>
<script>(function(d, s, id) {
  var js, fjs = d.getElementsByTagName(s)[0];
  if (d.getElementById(id)) return;
  js = d.createElement(s); js.id = id;
  js.src = "//connect.facebook.net/en_US/sdk.js#xfbml=1&version=v2.6";
  fjs.parentNode.insertBefore(js, fjs);
})(document, 'script', 'facebook-jssdk');
```

**Step 3:** Place this code wherever you want the plugin to appear on your page.

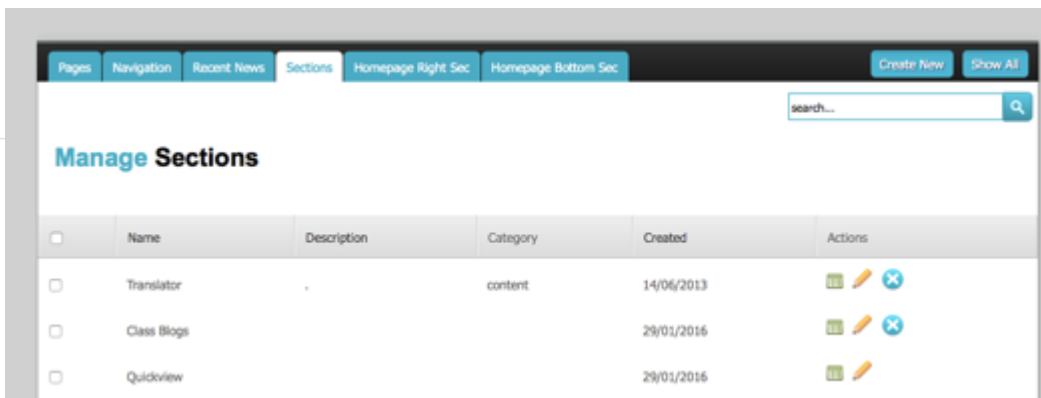
6. Click on iFrame and select and copy the code.

**Step 2:** Place this code wherever you want the plugin to appear on your page.

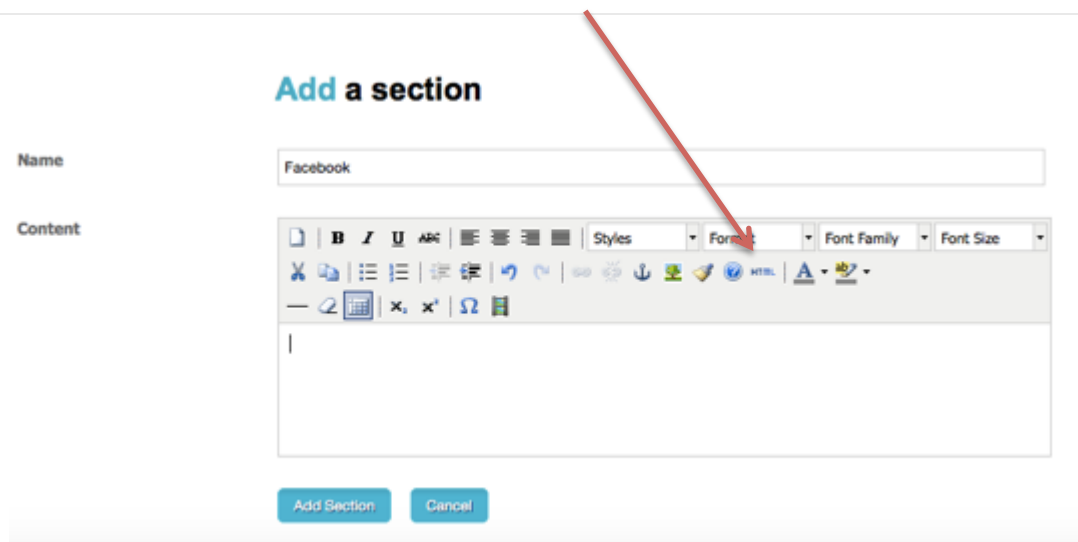

7. Go to the CMS of your website. WEBSITE CONTENT – Sections – Create New.

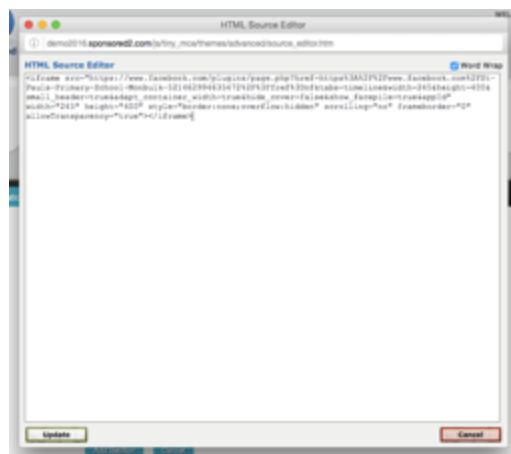

8. Give your section a title – such as Facebook.
9. In the content section – click on the HTML button in the toolbar.

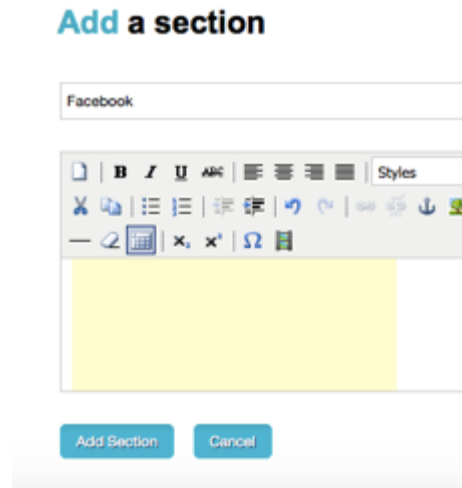


10. Paste the copied code into this box and click on UPDATE.



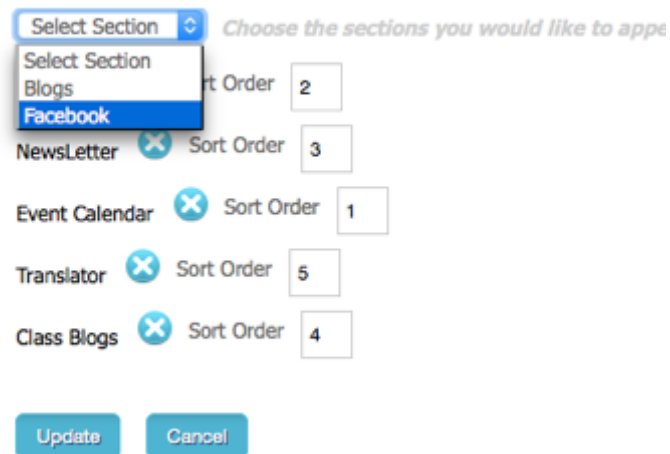

11. Your section will look like this. Click on ADD SECTION.



12. Go to **Homepage Right Section** and select your new section from the drop down menu.
