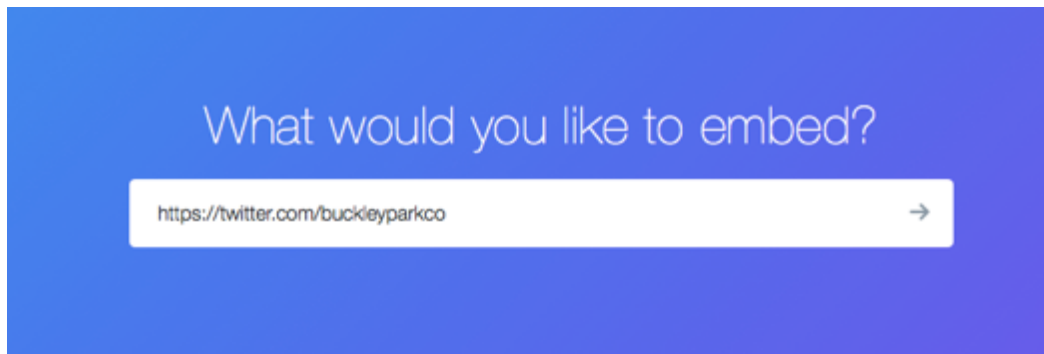


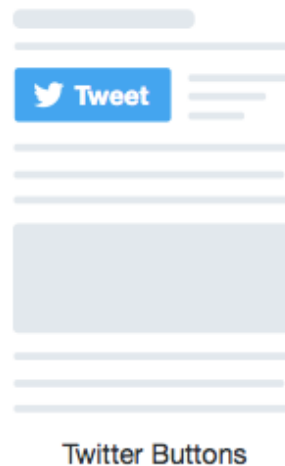
Adding a Twitter Feed to your Website

1. Go to <https://publish.twitter.com/>
2. Type or paste in your twitter URL
